Monday Night 2- Man League Rules

I. Introduction

- 1. League members must be, at least 18 years old and abide by all league rules.**
- 2. PLAY FAST . BE READY TO HIT!**
- 3. League will be played on Mondays. Matches can be played anytime after 2pm or later arranged with your opponent. If both teams agree to play another day of the week no payouts will be paid other than Monday matches (exception rain outs or holidays).**
- 4. Rain out matches must be played no later than Sunday before the next scheduled matches and will be eligible for all prize money (skins carryover).**
- 5. Monday Holidays matches will be played on Tuesday.**

II. Rules Committee/ Disputes/ Decisions

- 1. The Rules Committee Members are Rick Harter and Brian Allison. League Coordinator is Brian Allison (765-635-7082)**
- 2. The Rules Committee can make league and local rules pertaining to league play at anytime including but not limited to matters which affect points, standings, rule interpretations, etc.**
- 3. All league disputes, violations, and penalties, are subject to review by the Rules Committee.**
- 4. Decisions made by the Rules Committee are final.**

III. League Fees for 2024 (\$175.00)

1. The league total be paid in full the first night of play or prior to. If this creates a financial burden, half can be paid the first night and the remaining balance by June 30th

2. League payouts for weekly winnings will be made on the 30th of every month and final standings for year end will be paid at the season ending banquet.

IV. League Set Up

1. Each team will play the other teams once during the season plus one additional position week played at the end of the schedule.

2. We will play by stroke play only.

3. The league points system will be worth a total of six points.

Team Points – 2pts.

Individuals – 4 pts. (2pts. Per player)

1 bonus point will be awarded for teams that play on Monday, if Monday is cancelled no bonus points for any teams will be awarded. Also no bonus point on holiday matches moved to Tuesday.

4. Points are awarded after the round “A” player vs. “A” player, “B” player vs. “B” player. The player with the lowest net score will receive 2 pts for each match (A and B). Then two team points awarded for lowest net team score. If the players or team net score ties the points will be split.

5. If you play without an opponent any other day than Monday or Tuesday when Monday is a holiday, you forfeit 2 team points.

6. Any matches that are played without an opponent, all putts must be finished. NO GIMMIES FROM YOUR PARTNER!

V. League Play

1. This is a nine hole league.

2. Players under 65 years old must hit from the white tees.

***3. Players 65 and older(birthday anytime this year) may play from the yellow tees, 75 and older play yellow/ green combo tees and 82 and older from the red tees. Which tees you play must be determined at the start of the season and played throughout the year.**

***4. League play will be played under USGA rules and local rules. Ball may be rolled the length of a scorecard without changing cuts of grass(except when in the heather grass, play down or take a drop, line of flight, with penalty) or from behind trees (ball stays behind tree). Bunker play will be determined before the start of play.(Weather permitting bunkers will be playable with the rake and place rule.)**

5. Fence lines are out of bounds, if out, return to previous spot and play from there (1 stroke penalty) or take 2 stroke penalty and drop no closer than point which ball went O.B. A ball beside the fence in bounds, no relief from fences without incurring a 1 stroke penalty.

VI. Subs and Absentee Matches

1. Subs use the same handicap calculations as league members. Teams may use one sub per match. It is your teams responsibility to get a sub.

***2. In any absentee(forfeit) match, the team not showing receives zero points. The other team will be given 2 points for team total and play the field average("A" player and "B" player) for individual points. Except the last 2 weeks and position week will be played against team below in standings for all points.**

VII. Handicaps and Adjusted Score

1. Your actual score is to be posted on the scorecards.

2. For handicap purposes only (to help prevent “sandbagging”) nothing higher than triple bogey allowed for players over a 5 handicap. Nothing higher than a double bogey allowed for 5 and under handicap. This will be adjusted by the league coordinator. If you play without your opponent, scores will be adjusted within 3 strokes of your handicap only for handicap purposes.

3. Handicaps will be based on the average of the 4 of your last 5 rounds posted dropping high score, minus par, times 90%. The first four weeks will be based on adjusted average score from last year for first week played, plus scores posted for Weeks 1 thru 4 (x80%)

VIII. Rainouts and Lightning

1. If lightning is present you are to immediately take standard precautions. Rainouts will be determined by the Rules Committee. Take cover if the course warning horn sounds during a round. You will be notified if the round is postponed or cancelled.

2024 2-MAN LEAGUE LOCAL RULES

IMPROVING LIE OF BALL- You may improve your lie in the fairways and rough only. We cannot improve lie of ball in a hazard.

SANDTRAPS- Playability of sandtraps will be determined on day of play. If they are not playable, it will be posted at sign in location. If not posted,

you may rake and place where the ball had come to rest in the sandtrap. If sandtrap is under water, take relief no closer to hole, no penalty.

BOUNDARIES- Taking relief from all property fences will incur a 1 stroke penalty. Overgrown areas in front of fences are deemed lateral hazards. When ball comes to rest in the said area you may take drop at point of entry and incur a 1 stroke penalty. If player wants to play ball in hazard, lie of ball cannot be improved. When a player knows their ball has gone over property fences, this is out of bounds, incurring a 1 stroke penalty and distance (return to spot where ball was last struck and replay shot).

4) HEATHER AND WOODS- All “heather” to be played as a hazard or lateral hazard. Take allowed relief at point of entry(line of flight from last spot or tee) and 1 stroke penalty. If player finds ball and decides to play from that spot, there is no relief, play ball as it lies.
